
Dear Michael:

This letter confirms funding for the local project on N Mud Hen Lake Road from the 2018-2019 Town Road Improvement Discretionary Program (TRID), which is a component of the Local Roads Improvement Program (LRIP), a reimbursement program of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT). This program assists local units of government in improving deteriorating county highways, town roads, and municipal streets under the authority of the local unit of government by paying up to 50% of the total eligible project costs, with the balance matched by the local unit of government.

Your project was one of 65 TRID projects selected in Wisconsin for funding in the 2018-2019 biennium. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$217,800.00, and WisDOT will reimburse the Town of Daniels for N Mud Hen Lake Road up to 50% of the project's total cost, to a limit of \$108,615.30. You will soon receive a signed State/Municipal Project Agreement (SMA) from WisDOT.

Thank you for your commitment to provide a quality transportation system that fosters economic growth and job creation, while ensuring public safety. As a state and local partnership, we are working together to improve our transportation infrastructure. Congratulations on your project award as we move Wisconsin forward.
